WC Orientation – Led by Pastor Sterling Smith on the first Sunday of the month, new members and those curious to learn more about White's Chapel will gather in Grace Chapel and via Zoom at 12:15 p.m. to discuss topics such as the Methodist vows of membership, core Methodist beliefs and a review of various involvement and class opportunities. The orientation ends with a general question/answer session. All ages welcome.

WC Neighbor Food Drive – WC has an on-going, drop-off food drive. All donations are welcome and can be dropped off in front of the Administration Building or inside the East Welcome Doors in the back parking lot (M-Th 9 a.m. - 4 p.m.; Fri 9 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.). The food and other items donated are given to GRACE Food Pantry, transitional housing pantry, the WC Soldier Ministry boxes and families in need.

Super Saturday of Service: "Easter Joy" – This is a volunteer opportunity for our March Super Saturday of Service to be held March 20th from 9-11 a.m. Volunteers will be needed for set up, packing and delivering. Register online.

Fill the Gap – This is a 3-part volunteer opportunity for our weekend food program at O.H. Stowe Elementary and Van Zandt-Guinn Elementary, our Adopt-a-Schools. On the 1st and 3rd Monday of each month, there is a group that picks up the food order and delivers it to WC. On the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of each month, volunteers are welcome to come to the Concourse at 8:15 a.m. to help set up and/or at 10:30 a.m. to sort food items and pack bags to be delivered to the schools. In between you can register for Pastor John's Bible Study and breakfast from 9-10:30 a.m. Every Friday, registered volunteers will meet at O.H. Stowe and Van Zandt-Guinn at 10 a.m. to place the bags of food into labelled backpacks and deliver to the respective teacher classrooms.

Cooking with Care - Typically on the 2nd and 3rd Monday of each month, men and women join in planning, buying, preparing, and serving meals to the parents, siblings, and family members staying at the Ronald McDonald House in Fort Worth. Currently volunteers are not allowed onsite due to Covid; however, White's Chapel is funding boxed lunches instead.

Looms of Love – New ministry created to weave warm cozy hats and give them to people in need. A simple loom is used and no experience is necessary. Each hat made is given away through one of our various WC ministries. This group meets on Tuesdays from 3-4 p.m. in Room 3204 (Adult Education Building) from January 12th through March 9th.
