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Coffee & Conversation – Join Rev. Sterling Smith at Starbucks in Southlake Town Square on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of the month between 8-9 a.m. (come-and-go) for some coffee and casual conversation concerning our faith, our church, and our God.

Cooking with Care - Typically on the 2nd and 3rd Monday of each month, men and women join in planning, buying, preparing, and serving meals to the parents, siblings, and family members staying at the Ronald McDonald House in Fort Worth. Currently volunteers are not allowed onsite due to Covid; however, White's Chapel is funding boxed lunches instead.

Fill the Gap – This is a 3-part volunteer opportunity for our weekend food program at O.H. Stowe Elementary and Van Zandt-Guinn Elementary, our Adopt-a-Schools. On the 1st and 3rd Monday of each month, there is a group that picks up the food order and delivers it to WC. On the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of each month, volunteers are welcome to come to the Concourse at 8:15 a.m. to help set up and/or at 10:30 a.m. to sort food items and pack bags to be delivered to the schools. In between you can register for Pastor John's Bible Study and breakfast from 9-10:30 a.m. Every Friday, registered volunteers will meet at O.H. Stowe and Van Zandt-Guinn at 10 a.m. to place the bags of food into labelled backpacks and deliver to the respective teacher classrooms.

Oktoberfest Bag Stuffing – Volunteers meet to pre-stuff WC tote bags to be handed out at the WC Hospitality tent during Southlake Oktoberfest. Join us in the Annex area (across from Evans Hall) from 4-5:30 p.m. on Wednesday, September 29th. Register on the church website.

Serving with Love - On the 3rd Saturday of each month, volunteers travel to the Presbyterian Night Shelter in Fort Worth to serve women and children who are homeless or victims of domestic violence. Volunteers meet at White's Chapel at 4:15 p.m. for a prayer and to carpool (if wanted) to the Morris shelter to serve dinner and provide love, encouragement and fellowship to the women and children. Space is limited so volunteers are taken on a first-come, first-serve basis. Registration is required and all adult volunteers must be fully vaccinated (children 8 & up welcome to help).
